Large ovoid stoneware jar decorated with Cizhou cut-glaze technique in two registers of scrolling floral decoration. The dark brown glaze has been cut away before firing to leave an unglazed background for the design. Rim and footrim unglazed.

Condition: excellent condition.

Yuan to Ming Dynasty, 14th - early 15th century.
